The purpose of this sheet is to enable schools / groups to use this information for the development of risk assessments in order to satisfy the obligations placed by the Health and Safety at Work Act and the Management of Health and Safety at Work Regulations.

The following hazards have been identified as being inherent to the LEGOLAND Discovery Centre, Barton Square, The Trafford Centre, Manchester M17 8AS. Merlin Entertainments Group Ltd, the owner of LEGOLAND Discovery Centre, does not accept liability for any omissions to this list.

Control measures indicated are recommendations only and must be adapted / amended by group organisers.

| <b>Hazard</b>   | <b>Recommended Control</b>  |

| <b>Fire</b>   | Follow all evacuation instructions and signage.   |
| <b>Slips – Trips – Falls</b>                              | Beware of trips caused by guests looking at the themed displays and not at the floor, and of the excitement the attraction will create and the consequent potential collisions. The Group Organiser should ensure guests walk and do not run throughout the attraction, and exercise caution when approaching steps/stairs. |
| <b>Passenger lifts</b>                                    | Group Organiser supervision is required for young passengers.   |
| <b>Door Entrapment – Factory Tour Entrance and Exit</b>   | Beware of automatic doors closing on fingers and toes   |
| <b>Soft Play Areas</b>                                    | Follow all safety rules given in all areas of the attraction (particularly play area capacity rule). This activity should be supervised by the Group Organiser at all times   |
| <b>Kingdom Quest ride</b>                                 | Guests must adhere to the rules and regulations stated at the entrance of the ride.   |
| <b>Choking</b>  | Young guests must be supervised when playing with LEGO at all times due to the inherent risks associated with young children playing with small items that can be placed in the mouth.  |
| <b>Electrical Equipment</b>                               | Supervision is required: Tampering with any electrical equipment is prohibited.   |
| <b>Unruly Children</b>                                    | Please report the offending group to a team member immediately.   |
| <b>Environment</b>  | The attraction invokes great excitement, so Group Organisers must exert control over over-excited young visitors  |
| <b>Busy location – travel to and away from the Centre</b> | A coach drop-off point is located in Barton Square car park, no more than 200 metres from our entrance. The pick-up point is also   |

|  | in Barton Square. Pedestrian crossings must be crossed to both reach the attraction and the pick up point. Group Organiser must ensure appropriate level of supervision in order to facilitate this journey. |
