Programme of Study	Communication, Coordination, Team work, problem solving
Workshop Description	Through LEGO® Therapy children on the autistic spectrum are encouraged to communicate and solve a problem by being given specific roles. Working in teams of 2 or 3, children take turns in the assigned roles of 'engineer' 'builder' and 'helper' on a building task.
Duration	45 minutes (3 x 10 minute tasks)
Equipment	LEGO Duplo
Capacity	30 students per session*
Lesson objectives	Complete three models through delivering accurate instructions and displaying effective listening skills. Students will understand the need for team work, listening skills and attention. To Improve student's ability to interact with peers for a specific period of time. Encourages verbal and nonverbal communication, joint attention, task focus, problem solving and team work.
